Athletes must make their own travel arrangements. Attached is a letter to ask permission to miss school/work on Friday, 31 January 2020, if you will be travelling early.

Bed (Friday & Saturday evening) and breakfast (Saturday and Sunday morning) have been booked at a school hostel (Pinehurst, 186 Jan van Riebeeck Road). Families can be accommodated in private rooms or with other team members – 2 beds per room. We only have 80 beds available on a first-come-first-served basis. (*Entering Oudtshoorn from Calitzdorp/Cape Town R62, turn left at the first set of traffic lights, into Jan van Riebeeck Road. Second entrance on the right is Pinehurst.*)

Parents and supporters are welcome to stay with the team. Friday night supper will be at the Spur, at your own expense. You will also be responsible for your own lunch on Saturday. **NO BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED – don't forget to BRING YOUR OWN!**
